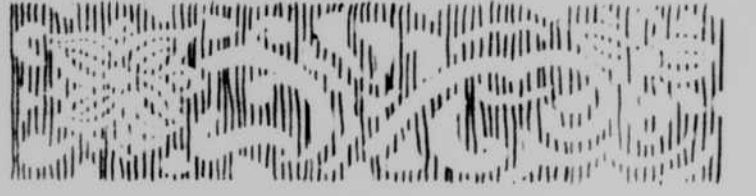
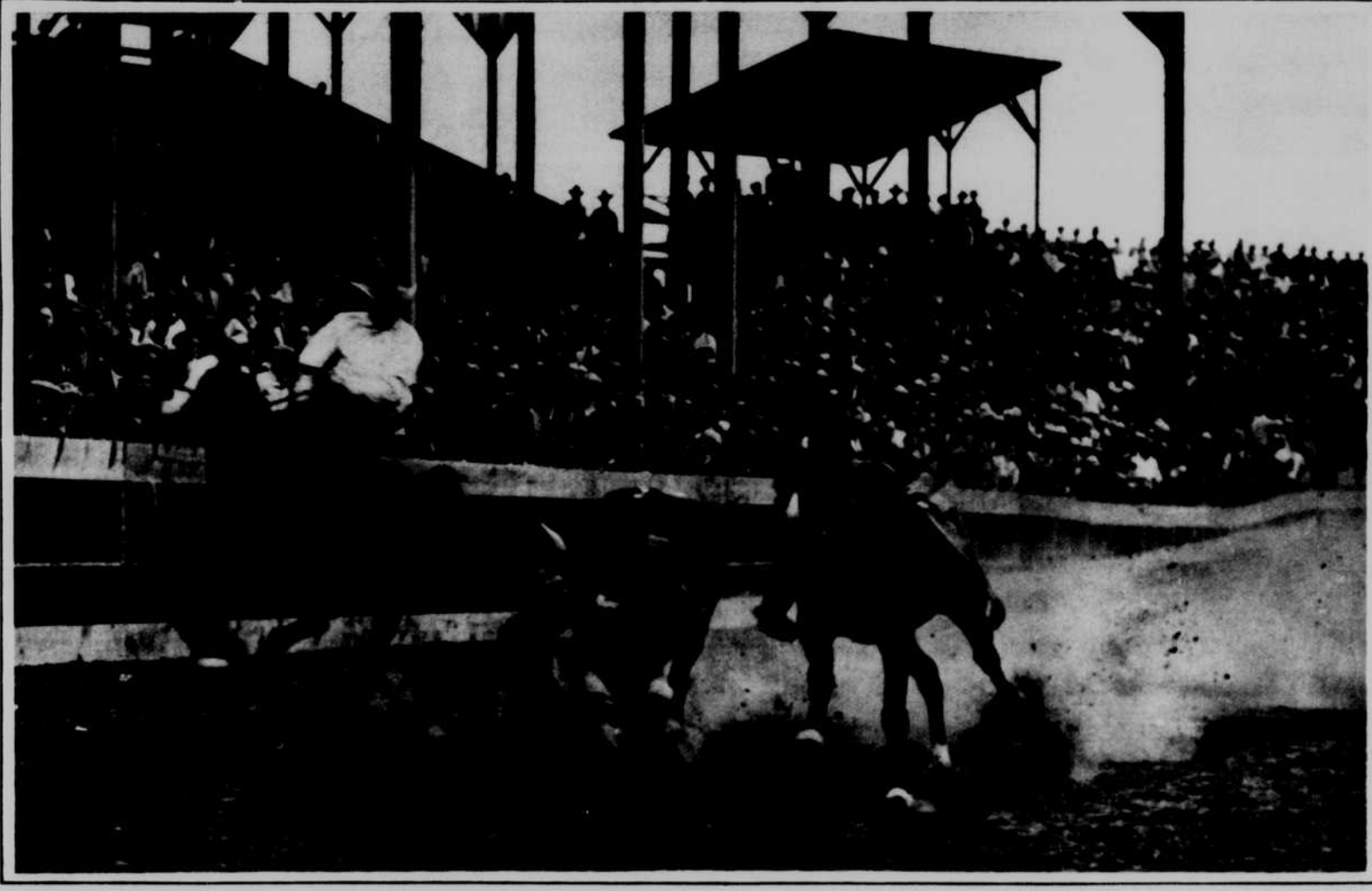




Bulldogging Johnny Rick shows some of the technique with which he hopes to win the bulldogging championship at the American Legion rodeo.
