Cullop, Osborne and Bonowitz Get Home Runs

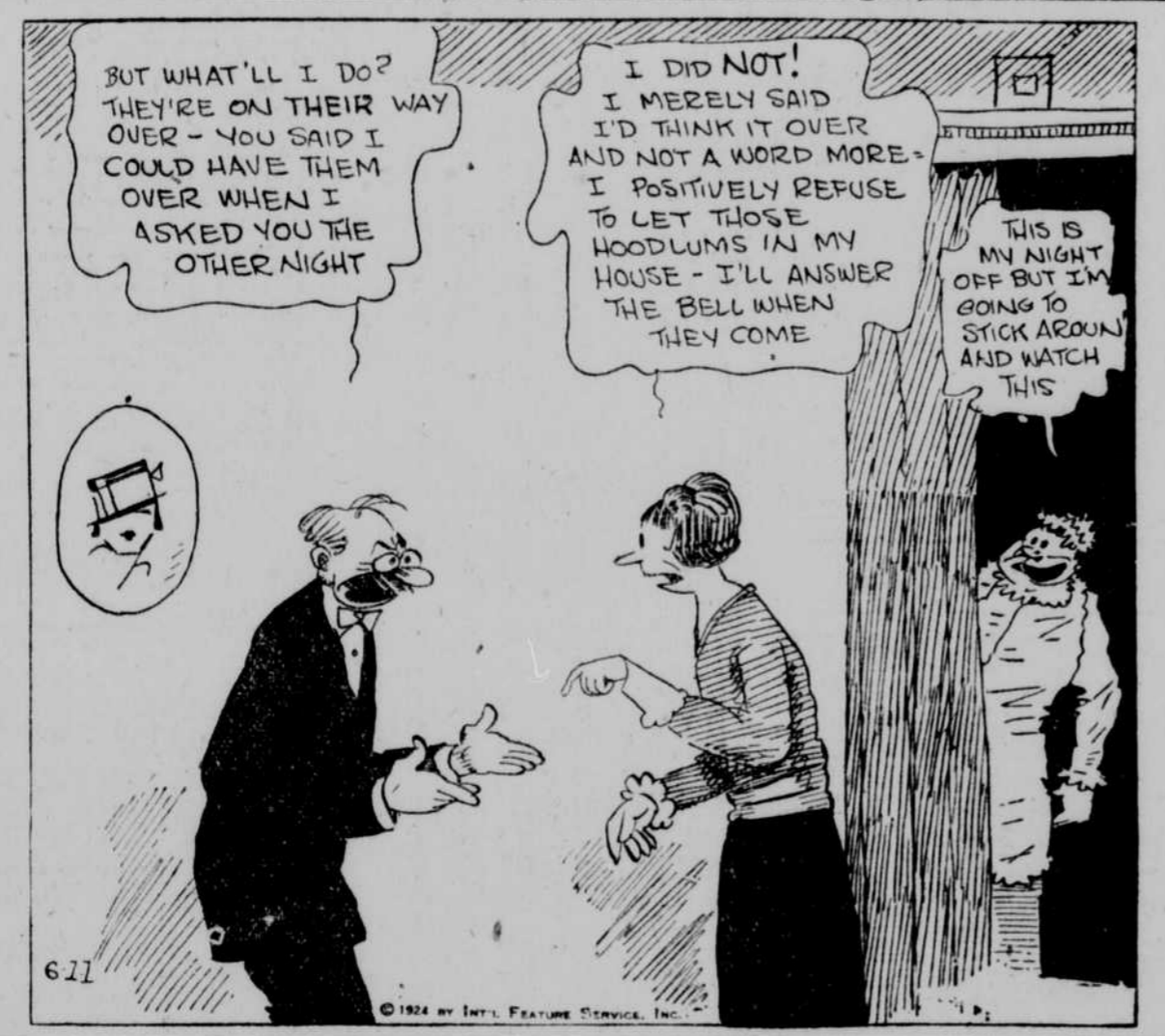
Omaha Loses First Game of Series With Wiches Out-Hit Winners, 14 to 13.
