

Winnipeg Leads Way as Wheat Sets New High Drought in Canada Combines with Livelier Export Business in Sending Market Upward.

By CHARLES J. LEYDEN. Universal Service Staff Correspondent. Chicago, July 14.—Wheat leading the way, wheat prices have advanced rapidly to new heights for the year and closed today at top levels. Winnipeg leads, with complaints of spreading damage, combined with the livelier export business to send the market upward. Heavy covering was credited to the market, while the bulls took profits on the bulge. Wheat closed 1/4 to 3/8 higher; corn 1/4 to 3/8 higher, while soy beans were 1/4 to 3/8 higher. The day from tomorrow, a local crop expert, who is an exceptionally well known authority about the final sharp flurry. He said: "Superintendents of grain elevators agree that the wheat will be half of last year in the first harvest. The situation is the worst in 50 years."

The only reason it doesn't pay a dividend is because there is a controversy over the company's assets. The company is a leader in the industry, and its stock has been a market favorite. The issue closed at 101 1/4 after selling within a year at 64. Dividend trouble brought the stock down, but it has since recovered and is now trading above par.
