

LABOR IN BATTLE FOR LA FOLLETTE

Trade Union Groups Organize for Spirited Campaign in His Behalf.

Labor's fight to put Robert M. La Follette in the White House is on.

The executive council of the American Federation of Labor in session here today decided to organize the most vigorous political campaign ever attempted by the trade union groups of this country.

Orders are to be issued which will put into the campaign each of the 3,000,000 members of the federation in every city.

Speakers will tour the country and towns of importance in behalf of labor's presidential choice will be distributed.

Daves Rapped. The report formally announced endorsement of La Follette is a complete statement of labor's political views.

It condemns the republican and democratic platforms along with the republican and democratic candidates. It points especially to Charles G. Daves, republican vice presidential candidate as "one of the most outspoken enemies of labor and founder of an organization dedicated to the task of writing into all political platform planks calling for an anti-union shop, a move which has long been opposed by the federation."

The LaFollette platform is sanctioned as regards domestic issues and reservation is made only under the LaFollette foreign policy in opposition to the league of nations and the international court of justice at The Hague.

Points which the report says La Follette boldly stands for in his platform include: Free Press. Free speech and free press—the right of labor to organize and collectively to cease to work.

abolition of the railroad labor board, restriction of the power of the supreme court, direct election of presidents and ratification of the child labor amendment.

"We cannot do otherwise than point out this fact, together with the further and perhaps more important fact that the candidates, LaFollette and Wheeler, have throughout their whole political careers, stood steadfast in defense of the rights and interests of the wage earners and the farmers," the report says.

Paul Revere's Ride Thrills All in Griffith's Picture, "America"

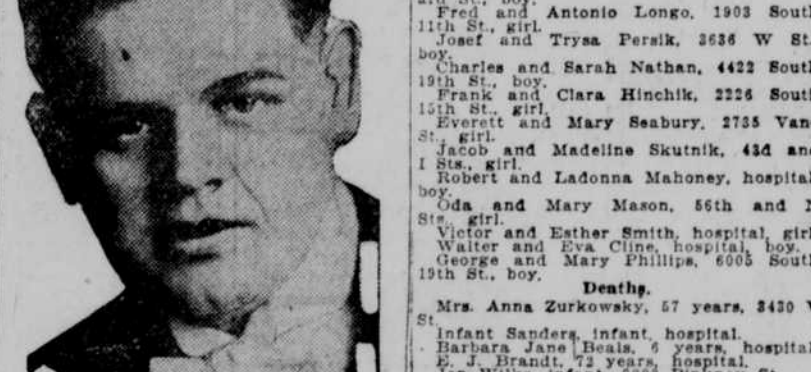


HARRY O'NEILL AS 'PAUL REVERE' IN D.W. GRIFFITH'S 'AMERICA'
