The market was characterized by a steady upward movement, with prices reaching new highs for the season. The uneasiness manifested during the latter part of the week apparently had subsided, but the market was still characterized by a general lack of interest. The political situation, particularly the subsidies following, was a major concern for investors. The market showed a sharp reaction on Friday, and this sentiment carried over into the current session. Trading was limited, and prices were generally flat.
