

Wheat Swings to Lower Levels and Closes Heavily

Corn Firm but Cannot Overcome Depressing Influence; Foreign Demand Weakens; Prices Drop.

Lacking the balance weight of public interest prices were unusually sensitive to any irregular selling or buying of a professional character. The setup was somewhat similar to that of the week and relative weakness in northwest markets gradually attracted enough selling to bring about a rapid giving way of prices late in the session.

December longs have been getting out of their holdings for several days and in some instances have been re-accumulating in the deferred months. This has had the effect of encountering fairly liberal selling at 1 1/4 to 1 1/2 for the May contract.
