Far East Will Be Present at First Drug Conference

U. S. to Be Represented at Second Meet—Plan to Stamp Out Opium Evil.

Geneva, Nov. 2.—Delegates will meet here tomorrow for the first of two international conferences which will attempt to solve the opium evil and what is of more immediate interest to the American people, endeavor to set up machinery to check the illicit international traffic in habit-forming drugs.

The first conference will be restricted to those far eastern countries where opium smoking prevails and to countries that have possessions in the far east where opium smoking is still permitted under the Hague convention of 1912.

This tendency has been embodied in a report of the League of Nations advisory committee on opium, which is an outgrowth of various draft conventions presented by various countries, including the United States, during the preliminary deliberations of the last year.

The idea behind this scheme is that if countries act in good faith there will be a drastic falling off in the production of opium, and that effective control will eventually achieve the aim of limiting production, which is the original American idea.

League of Nations officials understand that the United States federal government and the state governments have perfectly well in hand the manufacture of narcotic drugs, but that what the United States apprehends is the smuggling of habit-forming drugs into American ports.

Richard Strauss Quits Opera Job

Composer Resigns Post at Vienna Over Dispute With Management.

Berlin, Nov. 2.—A sensation has been created in European musical circles by the sudden resignation of Richard Strauss, famous composer, as director of the Vienna opera house, as a result of a row with the management.

The resignation came after the Viennese officials had gone to Dresden, where Strauss was superintending the production of his new opera, "Intermezzo," and laid before the composer elaborate and detailed instructions as to what he had to do and not to do and asked him to sign them.
