New York Sugar.

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New Tork, Dec. 15.—A decline of ½c to the basis of 4.90c for Cuban duty paid occurred in the raw sugar market today, owing to the increased offerlogs. Sales included 10.000 bags Cuban, early January clearance, at 4.96c; 29.000 bags for December clearance at 4.90c and 25.000 bags Porto Rican for January clearance at 4.60c.

Raw sugar futures were weak, with active positions selling at new low records for the season. The decline was due to renewed liquidation and hedge selling promoted by favorable weather in Cuba and increasing crop supplies. Closing Chosing promoted by favorable weather in Cuba and increasing crop supplies. Closing prices were near the lowest and 7 to 25 points below last week's finals, near positions showing the maximum loss. December closed 2.59c; March, 2.35c; May. 2.55c; July, 2.66c.
Refined sugar was easier and unchanged to 26 points lower, although list questions still ranged from 7.15 \$67.50c for fine granulated. Trading was light, Refined futures were nominal.
