Co-Operative Association's Report Makes Good Showing. Pawnee City, Dec. 16.—The auditor's report of the condition of the Farmers' Co-operative association of this city shows that the home-owned elevator and produce business owned and conducted by the association and incorporated in 1919 had one of the best years in the records of the company and that all indebtedness except a small amount has been retired. Reports of the manager of the elevator showed that 27,200 bushels of great were handled in the first 11 months of this year. Other totals were: Corn, 52,700 bushels; oats, 36,000; flour, 1,028 sacks. The produce house, which is conducted under separate management, handled 22,900 gallons of cream, 55,877 pounds of butter fat, 2,732 cases of eggs and 79,864 pounds of poultry.
