Coolidge Sees No Cause for Action on Reported French Attitude.

Washington, Dec. 30 .- President Coolidge has drawn no hasty conclusions from the recent swirl of de-velopments surrounding the French war debt and sees no occasion for action by the American government on the basis of present advices.

The president is watching the sitution closely, however, and should there be any indication of a move by the French government to repudithe White House stronfgly in its at- H. titude toward the floatation of private French loans in this country.

While there is no legal restriction giving the federal government authority over loans which foreign governments seek to place with pri-vate interests in this country, the advice of Washington usually is sought by the prospective investors and usually is sufficient to determine the fate of any such venture.
