## Capital City Team Expects Hard Contest

### Central Quintet to Meet Coach Browne's Hoopsters Night Following Bookkeepers' Battle.

Lincoln, Neb., Jan. 28.—Extensive drill in throw shooting was on the program for Coach W. H. Browne's Lincoln High Hoopsters Wednesday afternoon in preparation for the two big games of the year here, the Omaha Tech contest Friday evening and the Omaha Central clash Saturday night.

Donald Head and Walker will enter the fancy diving event; Elliston the 200-yard breast; Salter and Walker the 200-yard free; Ramsey the 100-yard back and free with Elliston also in the latter.

Grand Island will enter all the senior events, and Francis Merritt in the junior events. Lincoln will enter senior and junior events. McBride, who holds the 40-yard free, will enter that event and most of the other events. Lewis and Anderson will be in the dives and Stanley in the 200-yard free.

## Husker Cinder Athletes Keep Time of Trials

### Coach Henry Schulte Installs Pace Clock So Men Can Time Themselves.



Schulte has served notice that Thursday there will be another meet tryout for the K. C. A. C. indoor meet at Kansas City. Crites, Hein, Daily, Johnson and Gish are expected to line up in the 440-yard dash at 4 p. m.

In the 880-yard run, Cohen, Bays, Backford, Lawson, Dalton, Bushnell and Johnson will fight it out. The four best men in the squad will be used in the two-mile relay. In the mile event, Zimmerman and McCarthy will try out. Lewis will do the 600-yard run. Lewis has been making some nice time in this event.

In the 880-yard run, Tuesday afternoon, "Mud" Gardner and Howdersheldt put on a race. "Mud" made the distance in two minutes, 55.10 seconds, and Howdersheldt in two minutes, 17.10 seconds.

Coach Schulte is the first coach in the valley, so far as is known, to make use of the pace clock in the track so that the men can time themselves while taking their workouts. Nebraska has the advantage over

some of the valley schools this year in having a splendid indoor track. Workouts in field events are on every day, with the high jumpers being trained by "Hob" Turner. In the shot put, big Kriemelmeyer is increasing, his distance and now has a mark of 40 feet and six inches. He is new at the weight game and has shown good development for the time he has been in training.

Plans for the monster mass meeting will occupy most of the evening's session. The mass meeting, which is an annual affair, will be held in February.

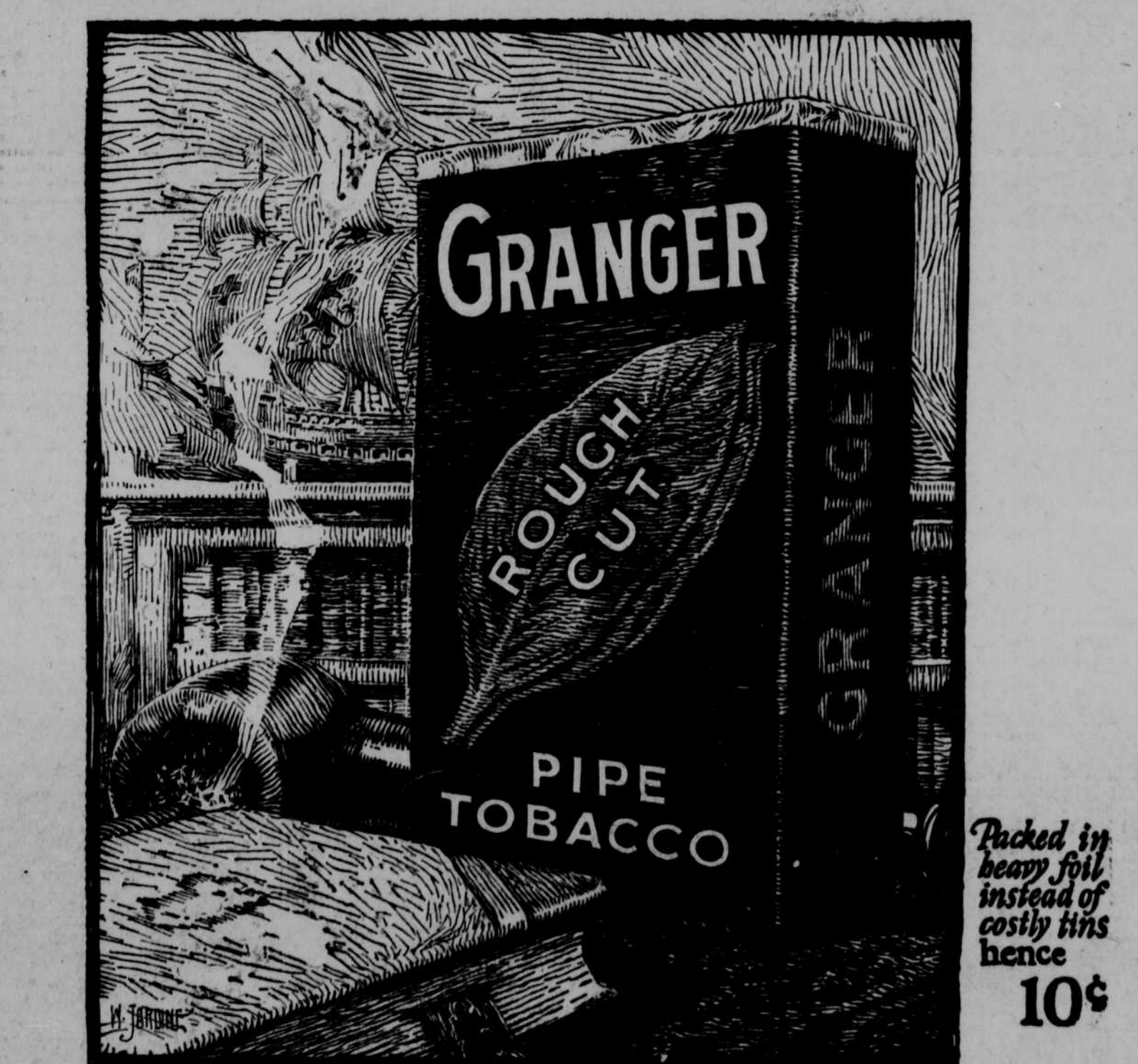
