Favorable Action of Senate on Stone Soon Is Predicted

Opposition to Appointment of Attorney General Has Not Collapsed Completely, but Is Weakening.

Washington, Feb. 2.—While opposition to confirmation of Attorney General Stone to be a supreme court justice has not completely collapsed, early favorable action by the senate is predicted as a result of the action today of the judiciary committee in reporting the nomination for a second time with its approval.

Both Senators Walsh and Hefflin, democrat, Alabama, had planned to discuss the nomination today, but decided to defer their remarks until tomorrow. Senator Hefflin, who said he would directly oppose confirmation, probably will speak at the open executive session, if one is ordered.

While not speaking in opposition to Stone's nomination, Senator Walsh had made it known that he will undertake to make clear his position with regard to the action of the Department of Justice in seeking an indictment in the District of Columbia against his colleague in connection with land permits, with regard to which one indictment already has been returned against Senator Wheeler in Montana.

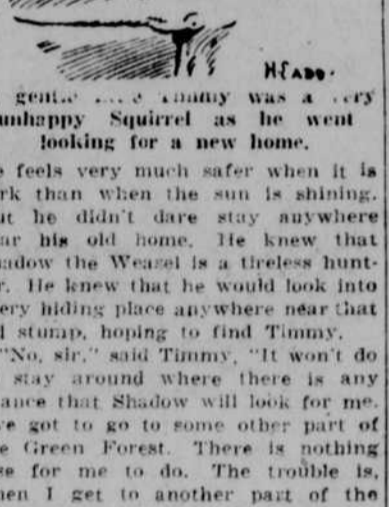
