

Wheat Swinging Erratically but Makes Fair Gains

New High for Present Movement Registered but Not Held; Domestic and Foreign News Bullish.

Omaha, Feb. 27.—Cash wheat sold on the tables today at 1 1/2c higher, and the influence of the continued strength in futures markets was clearly reflected in the cash market. Receipts were 10,000 bushels. Corn sold at unchanged prices to 1c higher, with only a fair demand. Rye and barley were quoted nominally unchanged.

Confidence has apparently been well restored from a buyer's standpoint of view. The market was again well supported on the dip, but it failed to make much headway. The selling of corn by a prominent cash house was considered a speculative move, but it failed to make much headway.
