

Interest in Grain Reduced Markedly, Sag in All Prices

Session Is One Sided and Wheat Leads All Others to Bottom, Where They Close.

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Omaha, March 24.—Speculative interest in the grain list today showed marked reduction, and with wheat in the lead position, all others followed. Corn was down to lower levels. All grains finished at the bottom. Wheat displayed a firm tone, which was due to the strength in Liverpool, and further favorable crop news from the southwest, where the new season has been lived and repeatedly encountered pressure.

Wheat finished 2 to 4½ lower; corn was 2½ to 3 lower; oats were up to 1½ down and rye rule 2½ to 2½ off.

Barley and barley was quoted nominally about unchanged.

Cash wheat sold on the tables at about unchanged prices compared with yesterday's quotations. Receipts were generally light and scarcity of offerings gave way to more or less general dullness, although a good demand was reported. Receipts were but 6 cars.
