

Prices of Wheat Off Sharply and Close at Bottom

General Mill Strike Pending in United Kingdom Big Factor in Decline; Markets Vulnerable.

Chicago, April 13.—Continuous selling of wheat futures today, largely in the course of profit taking and credited for the decline, was the main factor in the unusually vulnerable and sent prices off sharply. The close was heavy and at the same time the market was considered to be in general demand around unchanged levels.

Corn was in good demand around unchanged levels.

Oats sold around unchanged prices to low lower. Receipts were 24 cars.

Wheat finished 2½ to 3¢ lower; corn 2½ to 3¢ lower; oats 2½ to 3¢ lower and barley about unchanged.

GRAN Exports.

Washington, April 13.—Grain exports from the United States last week were 2,229,000 bushels, compared with 2,468,000 bushels.

The reduction was about as expected and the bushels were 56,244 more than bushels compared with 56,675,000 bushels a year ago.

In most markets, however, it was not active and prices eased with the futures. A report from St. Paul said no northern grain wheat was purchased to come here for delivery on May contract help along.

Local reports were inclined to believe favorable conditions in the market had been brought about by the recent price decline.

However, a local expert was out with a statement placing the market in a position to move up again.

Wheat was off with wheat, trade was 100,000 bushels a day, and in the middle of the week supply was 100,000 bushels.

Provisions eased under pressure of commission house liquidation. Lard was 50¢ off and hogs were unchanged to up.
