Labor Department Figures Show Advance in Wholesale Food Prices.

By International News Service.

Washington, April 17 -The cost of living continues to climb, wholesale prices of foodstuffs being 71/2 per cent higher in March than they were a year ago, the Department of Labor announced today.

While some commodities averaged lower in price in March than in February, the general average was

slightly higher. Fresh Foods Advance.

Principal advances were noted in fresh foods, such as meats, butter fruits, which were offset in part by slight declines in eggs, flour, etc. Th net increase for the group was 114

Jobs also were less plentiful, the De partment of Labor announced. While employment in manufacturing indus tries increased 1 per cent in March over February, it was 4 per cent lowe than March a year ago.

Based on reports from 9,000 estab lishments in 52 industries covering 2,808,019 employes, whose total earn ings during one week in March were \$75,422,103, the aggregate earnings of employes increased 1.8 per cent, while the per capita earnings increased 0.5

Employment Gain.

The fertilizer industry showed the largest employment gain amounting to 40 per cent. The brick industry in creased 9 per cent in employment hile the automobile and carriage in dustries showed increases of 7.2 per

There was a marked decrease in the employment in the chewing and smoking tobacco industries, slaughtering and meat packing, flour, confec tionery, woolen goods and rubber The food group boots and shoes. lost over 3 per cent of its employes.


