ENTERING TOWN SITES. The following correspondence will show that the act of the last Legislature of the Territory, designating the County Commissioners as the proper persons to enter Town Sites, is not recognized by the Commissioner of the Land Office.

EXTRACT OF A LETTER TO THE COMMISSIONER OF THE LAND OFFICE, DATED OMAHA, April 15, 1857. Under the act of twenty-third May, 1844, the "Judges of the County Court" are given the authority to enter "Town Sites."
