**Labor Locals Picked Up in Lincoln and Elsewhere.**

 Ed Fagan, a member of Bartenders' Union, has been granted a license for a saloon on North Ninth street.  
 Painters announce that business is especially dull in Boston and request

all travelers to give that city a wide berth at present.  
 The announcement of an increase of five and ten cents a day for the railway clerks of the New York, New Haven & Hartford railroad is not being taken as a general cause for elation by the men who made an original request for approximately a 15 per cent increase.  
 Word has been received by officials of the Amalgamated Association of Iron, Steel and Tin Workers that the Whitaker-Glessner company, of Wheeling, has signed the scale. The Pope company, at Steubenville, and the Follansbee company of Follansbee, W. Va., have also signed the scale.  
 It is claimed for the Journeymen Barbers' Union the unique distinction of being the only labor union that has never had a strike, yet in spite of this fact the conditions of the journeymen barbers have been constantly improved. Shorter hours, better wages and Sunday closing are some of the results of organization in the craft, which now has a membership of 40,000.

demands of the journeymen have been acceded to and the men returned to work. The strike lasted eight weeks. Strike of brassworkers at the Stratford, Ont., works of the Grand Trunk has been won. Men receive an increase of 2 to 3 cents an hour.  
 The Middlesex Plating company, a concern at Lowell, Mass., that has been hostile for years, signed an agreement.  
 Boston coopers have asked for a 25

cents a day increase. Some of the largest shops have granted the request.  
 The ten per cent increase in wages in the shops of the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad company has gone into effect.  
 Laundry work is one of the most healthy forms of labor, and especially female labor, that can be found, and we challenge anyone claiming the contrary to produce anywhere in any

industry a finer and healthier class of girls than are to be seen any day of the week in a modern sanitary laundry.—Laundry Worker.  
 The members of the Ladies' Auxiliary to the Toledo Machinists' Unions resolved at their last meeting to parade on Labor Day.  
 All the bookbinders in St. Joseph, Mo., have joined the local union and the employers have signified their willingness to sign up and the out-

come will be a closed shop in all the binderies.  
 The strike of the iron ore miners in the Mesaba range has been settled. The men return to work under the old conditions on promise that their grievances will be arbitrated.  
 Twelve hundred girls, shirt makers in New York city are on strike for an increased wage. Two hundred of them are on picket duty and doing their work well.
