lead to the degrees of Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science. The studies are such as long experience has taught best adapted to develop the mental, moral and physical faculties of man and woman.

The normal department offers two, three, and four year courses. The two years course prepares students for second grade county certificates, and the three and four year courses are planned for the purpose of preparing students for first grade county certificates. At present students have

little difficulty in securing positions, because of the scarcety of teachers. Special attention is given to students who desire to fit themselves for second grade certificates in one year.

The commercial department offers excellent courses in business, stenography and typewriting. The pupil is in turn a stenographer, a book-keeper, a merchant, a banker, doing actual business just as carefully and accurately as in real life. The daily school work constitutes a business experience. Stenography, typewriting and the work of

the counting room are taught thoroughly in theory and in practice, and supplemented with courses in English, arithmetic, penmanship, commercial law, geography, rapid calculation and German.

Noting the demand among young ladies for instruction in dressmaking Dana, College has engaged a professional dressmaker and offers instruction in cutting and sewing; thus the young lady students while pursuing their regular courses of study may get such instruction in cutting and sewing as they desire.
