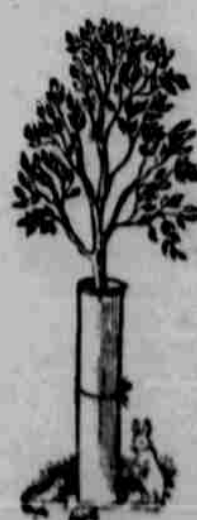

SAYS CAMPUS SMELLS OF OIL

Senator Dolliver Describes Chicago University Atmosphere

Sedan, Kas., Oct. 23.—Senator J. P. Dolliver of Iowa, in a public speech here Saturday night, made the statement that the influence of John D. Rockefeller is so potent in the teachings of the professors of the University of Chicago that the campus smells like a Kansas oil town.
He did not mention the name of Rockefeller, but left the implication so strong that all knew very well who was meant. Senator Dolliver called

attention to a book on political economy written by Prof. Myers, in 1902, when a teacher in the University of Wisconsin, in which good, wholesome doctrines of political economy and sociology were set forth along the same lines held by Prof. Ely of the same institution.

A few years later Prof. Myers went to the Chicago university to teach, and in 1905 wrote a new book, the exact opposite of the one he wrote three years before. In this last book he alleges that those who hold the views he expressed three years before lacked good sense. Senator Dolliver referred to the oily views of

the university al... made a strong and eloquent plea that American universities be put upon a higher plane than one which permits the influence of money to shape the teachings of the professors along the lines of sociology and political economy. He regards this as liable to become a dangerous situation and as one which sets up a false standard of business and moral ethics.
