This Year ... MAKE CANNING A SIMPLE JOB ... ELECTRICALLY • Cool Quick Clean Convenient With the electric range, canning doesn't mean long, tiresome hours in a steaming, hot kitchen. The "cold-pack" or "jar-pack" method is used. Put the cold food in cold jars, use cold water and put the jars in a cold oven . . . then turn on the heat and the food cooks right in the jars in the same position in which you have packed it.
