In a speech to the Ethiopian parliament assembled in Addis Ababa, Emperor Haile Selassie declared, that he "will not hesitate to give his blood for the independence of his country." If need be, he continued, he was prepared to die leading his subjects on the field of battle.

Addis Ababh, Ethiopia, July 31, CNA-Asserting that the Ethiopian people will offer armed resistance in defense of their political independence and territorial nitegrity, Emperor Haile Selassie spiked false rumors of acceding to any of Mussolini's demands for ard University. land concessions or to aprotectorate over Ethiopia.

"Under no circumstances will in or through Ethiopia administered or policed by Italy," Selassie emphatically stated, "because lowed by annexation."
