The Executive Committee of the Communist Party is one of the highest bodies of the World Communist movement.

During the sessions of Congress, Miss Henderson of the South African Communist Party was elected to the Presidium, the governing body of the Congress.

Natives Taught Bible Consigns Them To Inferior Status

Johannesburg, S. Africa, Sept. 12.—(ANP)—R. F. Alfred Hoernle, head of the department of philosophy and psychology in the University of Witwatersrand here, writes an interesting comment for the Congregationalist, reproduced in the South African Outlook, the success white missionaries have had in persuading African natives to the belief that God intends for them always to be servants of the whites.

"Are you going against the Bible by appealing to us natives to seek education and to strive to advance when it is the will of God, as declared in the Old Testament, that we natives shall always remain hewers of wood and drawers of water?"
"On further inquiry," Hoernle writes, "I found that this same text (the Bible curse against Ham) had been quoted by Bible-trusting whites as justifying the policy of holding down the black peoples of Africa to service and menial work, and to a correspondingly subordinate status in the social structure."

"The whole philosophy of 'Kafir-ism', the whole principle of permanent economic inferiority for the Bantu has been made thereby to wear the sacred air of a God-willed arrangement."

Mr. Hoernle also explained the South African maxim of "no equality between white and black in church and state. He writes:

"In detail, this means (a) that natives must be excluded from political power, lest by the weight of their numbers they rule the whites; (b) that there must be no social intercourse between white and black on a footing of equality; that there must be segregation in trains and trams, in schools and churches; that whites and blacks must not work on the same jobs side by side, nor in the same rooms in factories. (c) that no native must ever occupy a position or status in virtue of which he would have the right to give orders to a white man, let alone a white woman; (d) and some would even go so far as to demand that no native's wage must ever equal that of a white, for equal standards of life imply social equality."

Disease May Rob Electric Chair Of Victim

MHolly Springs, Miss., Sept. 12.—(ANP)—Believing that pellagra, with which he is afflicted, will save the state the expense of an electrocution, Judge Taylor McElroy, postponed the trial of Tommy Lee Brown, charged with four murder charges to February 1936, here Tuesday when the stricken man was brought into the courtroom on a cot.

Brown is charged with the murder of four members of the Wicks family, white, whom he shot and killed five months ago. He was indicted on four murder charges and the trial was set for Tuesday. Since being in jail the defendant has been stricken with pellagra and county physicians have expressed the opinion that he will die within ninety days.

Disabled Vets Entertain National Commander

Chicago, Sept. 12.—(ANP)—Members of John H. Patton chapter of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War, entertained National Commander Marvin Harlan of El Paso, Texas, Mr. Harlan, a southern man, was born in Mississippi and lived in Oklahoma for a number of years. He is a civil engineer in private life.

The invitation to gather with members of Patton chapter was extended through Edward Perry, commander of the chapter, which has headquarters at 118 E. 46th street.

Among those present were: Edward M. Sneed, Democratic committeeman of the Third ward; Roy Cunningham of Hines chapter; Carter Smith, past member of the national executive committee. George Brown, state adjutant; M. F. J. Mackey, of the rehabilitation department; H. Roberts, past state commander, and J. Levitt Kelly, organizer of the Retail Clerks Union.

Commander Harlan charged that the army, navy and national guard are shot through with Communism and asserted that it was one of the aims of the Disabled American Veterans to combat this activity.

Ex-Supreme Chancellor Green Seeks Back Pay

New Orleans, La., Sept. 11, (ANP)—"Pay up or I will sue" was the cryptic message sent by ex-Supreme Chancellor S. W. Green, of the Knights of Pythias of North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa and Australia, to T. G. Nutter, Supreme Master of Exchequer, last week.

According to the statement of Mr. Green who was supplanted by S. A. T. Watkins of Chicago as Supreme Chancellor at the recent meeting of the fraternal organization held at Rochester, N. Y., the sum of sixteen thousand one hundred and seven dollars and fifty-seven cents (\$16,107.57) is due him in salary and if the same is not paid by September 30, 1935, a suit will be entered to recover the full amount.

It develops that during the recent lean years for Pythianism, that Mr. Green has been playing the role of Daman, bearing the expenses of his office out of his own pocket.

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Dr. Huggins Tells Of Program To Aid Ethiopia

Ethiopian Minister To London Approves Program

New York City, Sept. 11, (ANP)—Two thousand men and women gathered at the Rockland Palace, Eighth avenue and 135th street, here Friday night, to hear Dr. Willis N. Huggins, who has recently returned from Abyssinia and London, describe conditions faced by the Ethiopians in the impending conflict between Ethiopia and Italy and the program of activity in which American Negroes can participate.

Dr. Huggins pointed out that Premier Mussolini was determined to take possession of Ethiopia to extend Italian territorial limits and to gain control of the natural resources of the African country. To do this, the Duce is willing and ready to plunge the entire world into another war.

Representing the International Council of Friends of Ethiopia, Dr. Huggins, on August 15, placed an appeal before the committee of the secretariat of the League of Nations at Geneva requesting that the League "take measures to restrain gross infringement of international law and agreements often ratified."

Dr. Huggins, in his program here, urged a "non military aid for Ethiopia" seeking funds from friends of Ethiopia to aid them in conflict rather than any attempt at armed intervention. Medical supplies are needed! Money is needed as well as medical men, nurses, and the like, who are willing to make the necessary sacrifice to aid Abyssinia in protecting their independence.

Dr. W. C. Martin, Ethiopian minister to London, has endorsed the program of Dr. Huggins and scored bitterly Premier Mussolini, declaring that "Mussolini seems to think the best way to civilize us is to kill us off, but I must beg to differ with his high and mighty exellence on this point."

"Just let us have peace for 20 years and a loan of say \$100,000,000 to enable us to open schools and develop our resources and I can assure you that Ethiopians will be as far advanced at the end of that period as any one could wish."

Says Italy A Nation Of Slaves
Discussing the question of slavery, Dr. Martin said: "Mussolini says Ethiopians are slaves, but the Ethiopians certainly are not treated as badly as the Italians by Mussolini today."

"Italians have far more need of emancipation than we do. My point out when we entered the League of Nations in 1923, the Italian delegate said 'Slavery in Ethiopia has been reduced to a mild form of serfdom.' One of our emperors made a grave mistake when he gave Eritrea to Italy. The unwise gift sharpened Italy's appetite and she is now trying to take our whole kingdom."

Dr. Huggins is planning to tour the country in the interest of promoting his program for aiding Ethiopia, and endorsing his efforts, Dr. Martin, Ethiopian minister to London, in a statement to the ASSOCIATED NEGRO PRESS, said:

"I desire to inform the colored people of America that Dr. Willis Huggins has been introduced to me through the International Council of Friends of Ethiopia in London, and I would like to thank the colored people of America for any support they may give his efforts on behalf of Ethiopia."
