The association's letter pointed out that the federal investigators did not wait for the elapsing of seven days, as provided by the fed eral kidnaping law, in order to be come active in the Mattson case, but mushed in simultaneously with the report of the kidnaping to the Tacoma police. Eight federal agents were sent into Tacoma almost before the police teletype machines had finished recording the kidnapng of the Mattson boy.

Theoretcally, if a state line is not rossed, the job of arresting and mnishing the kidnapers is supposed to be confined to the state officers. In raction, howev !, the G-men have ignored this portion of the law and have rushed into every kidnaping except the Neal kid-
