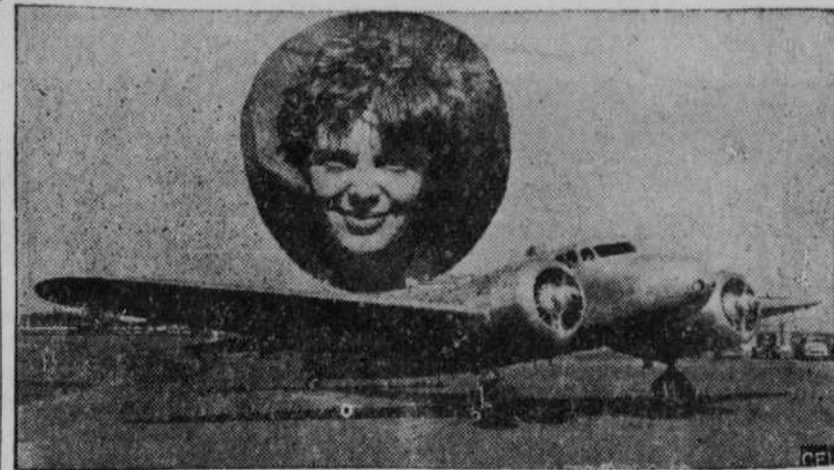




JOE LOUISES SPIKE RUMOR OF MARITAL RIFT
