Choosing Your Oress An old, reliable rule to follow is this: Short girls should wear clothing with up-and-down lines, either in the cut of the garment or the design of the goods, while tall girls should wear ensembles which emphasize the crosswise lines.

To get some idea on how important this rule is, draw two ovals, shaped like eggs standing on end, on two different pieces of paper. Then draw half a dozen up-and-down lines through one of them, and draw cross-wise lines across the other. 
