Washington, D. C., Oct. 28 (By D. W. Chase for ANP)—The Association for the Study of Negro Life and History announces its annual meeting which will be held Oct. 31 to Nov. 2nd. This was made known by Garnet C. Wilimson, chairman of the general committee The Association was organized in Chicago about 20 years ago by Dr. Carter G. Woodson, well known historian and an acknowledged authority on Negro history and folk lore.

The Association has for its object collecting sociological and historical data, the publishing of books on Negro life and history and promoting the study of the Negro through clubs and schools and bringing about harmony between the races by correctly "interpreting one to the other."
