

Singer Salesmen Strike To Protest Firing

New York, April (CNA)—Sixteen Negro salesmen and collectors employed at the 317 West 125th Street branch of

the Singer Sewing Machine Company went on strike this week after the discharge of eighteen others. The strikers are members of the United Retail Employees, CIO.

Frank Crosswaith, chairman of the Negro Labor Committee said that the strike would be tended to other Singer Branches unless it is settled. He pointed to the support of the strikers by white employees of the company and said that they were ready to come out on strike of extension of the struggle became necessary.

The State Labor Board has been asked to act on the eighteen discharges.

The Singer Company is one of a number of 125th Street firms that have recently come around to hiring Negro salesmen, clerks, etc., as a result of pressure by the Harlem community and organized labor.

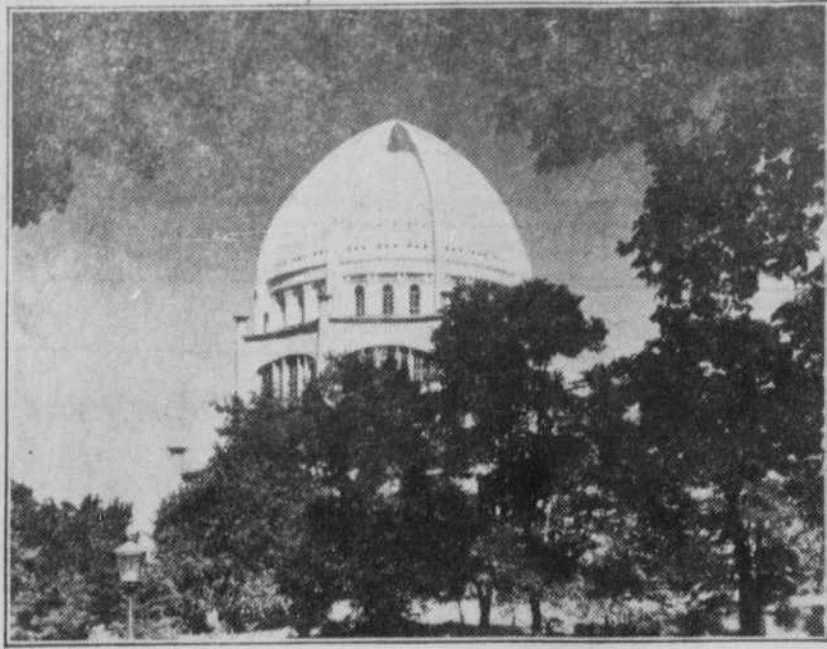

ANTI-LYNCH BILL RALLY CALLED FOR UNION SQUARE April 13

NEW YORK, April (CNA)—More than 30,000 people will jam Union Square Wednesday afternoon April 13 at a mass demonstration for immediate Congressional passage of the Wagner-Van Nuys anti lynch bill. Gladys Stoner, chairwoman of the Preparation Committee, declared. The action is sponsored by the New York Council of the National Negro Congress.

Prior to the demonstration a parade will be held in Harlem April 9 to further publicize the anti lynch bill. The parade has been endorsed by 10 Harlem Civic and religious organizations.

The Union Square meeting will be addressed by the Rev. A. Clayton Powell, Jr., pastor of the Abyssinia Baptist Church, the Rev. John W. Robinson, pastor of the Christ Community Church, and Dr. Max Yergan, of the International Committee on African Affairs. The Harlem Coordination Committee on Jobs and Unemployment, the Abyssinia Baptist Church, the State, County and Municipal Workers' Union, the International Labor Defense and the International Workers' Order, have endorsed the meeting.

The Communist Party, the only political body that has endorsed the bill and rallied wide public support for its enactment, issued a statement urging "every member of the Communist Party, every progressive, every sincere fighter for equal rights for the Negro people and for the end of mob violence, discrimination and segregation" to participate in the demonstration in such numbers that even the most reactionary Southern Congressmen and Senators will be forced to recognize that progress in America will not tolerate lynch terror.

SAYS WOMEN'S RIGHTS' BILL IGNORE NEGRO

Indianapolis, Ind., April 16—(CNA)—Pointing out that the "Equal Rights Amendment now before the U. S. Senate denies special protection for women and fails to recognize existing discrimination against Negro women, the Women's Commission of the Communist Party of Indiana this week urged action to prevent passage of the measure.

In New York, the Consumers League of New York also voiced opposition to the proposed amendment which is supported mainly by society women groups. The League asserted that "all laws for women workers for which the Consumers' League has worked for many years will be nullified," under the amendment.

"We do not want a misnamed 'liberty' that would deprive the weak and defenseless of essential safeguards," a league bulletin stated.

NAZIS BAR JEWS FROM UNIVERSITIES

Vienna, April 16—(CNA)—Jewish students will not be accepted at Austrian universities, Oswald Menghin, Minister of Education under the new Nazi regime imposed on Austria following Hitler's seizure of this country, said this week. Menghin added the threat that Jews now attending universities may be forced out "at any moment."

The campaign of race hatred which has spread from Nazi Germany to Austria following the Hitler coup was further sharpened by an attack on the Jewish people by Herman William Goering, Hitler's representative, in a speech opening the campaign for the April 10 "plebiscite," on the "union" of Austria and Germany. Goering declared that the Jews must get out of Naziland. He revealed plans to take over business concerns.

One thousand Austrian police men who had used their office to secretly further the Nazi campaign against Austria were cited for their services to Hitler in an official announcement, giving them the privilege of wearing a special emblem of honor as a reward for the under work.

All Jews in Burgenland town of Frauenkirch and Deutschkreutz, numbering several hundred, have been arrested by Nazi secret police and placed in a concentration camp near Beard. All their property has been confiscated, leaving them penniless.
