



The United States Supreme Court has set aside the conviction of a Negro found guilty of mur-We Buy Old Gold der in Kentucky because the "sys tematic and arbitrary exclusion" of Negroes from the jury lists in that State constitutes a denial ot constitutional right. Under those circumstances the court concluded


that the defendant had not been given a fair trial. This decision is on all fours with the one handed down by the court some years ago in the case of one of the Scottsboro defendants. The response in that case, so far as the Alabama authorities were concerned, was immediate and praiseworthy. Gov. Graves declared that in Alabama the decision would be accepted "in letter and in spirit." It has been. Some other States which had practiced exclusion of Negroes from juries also took the cue.

Apparently Kentucky was remiss in its duty in this particular. That State continued indefensible racial discriminations. But the intent of the Supreme Court to crack down on such practices which do violence to democratic principles and constitutional rights is now unmistakable. Once again the highest tribunal of American liberties.

If States still excluding Negroes from jury service expect to have their law enforcement efforts upheld in the Federal courts, they had better get into step with this liberal interpretation.





