AS ALICE ALMOST RAN INTO A MOUNTED KNIGHT, HE CALLED OUT, "AHOY! AHOY! CHECK!"



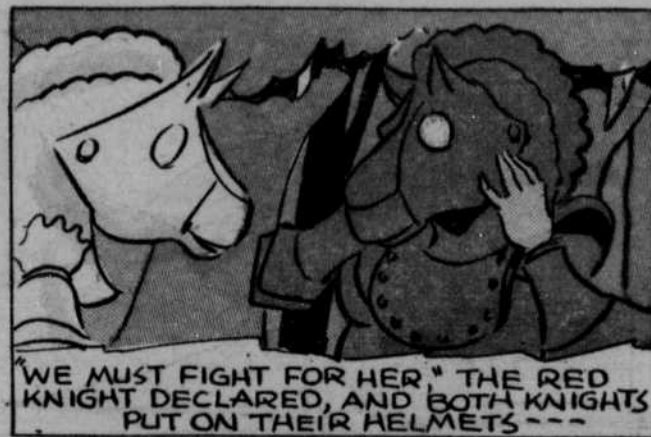
---AND THEN DISMOUNTED WITH A CRY OF "YOU'RE MY PRISONER."



BUT "AHOY! AHOY! CHECK!" WAS AGAIN HEARD AS A WHITE KNIGHT DREW UP.



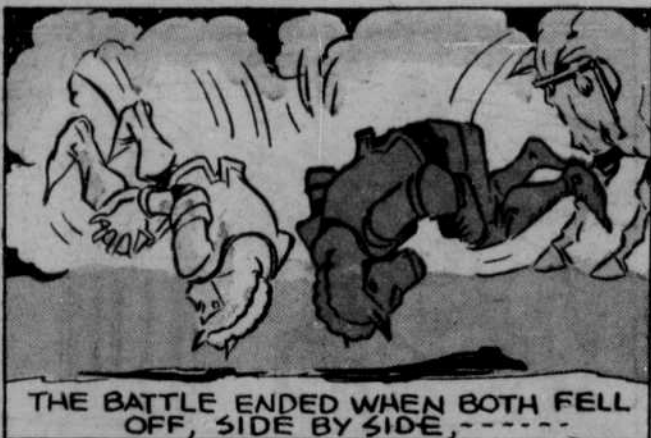

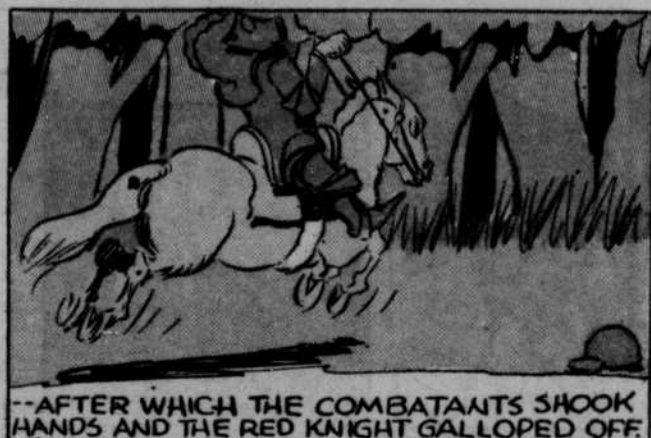
