### Observe Fisk Jubilee Day Throughout Nation Famed Fisk Singers Mark 67th Anniversary

ONLY LIVING MEMBER OF ORIGINAL TROUPE AND PRESENT HONORED

Nashville, Oct. 8 (ANP)\_The 67th anniversary of the "going forth" of the Original Jubilee Singers will be observed at Fisk university, and in all sections of the country on Oct. 6, The observance will be carried out in various schools and churches of America in recognition of the signifiant part the inrtepid group played in the educational advancement of the Negro. At high noon Fisk men and women everywhere will pause in silence a sPresident Thomas Elsa Jones leads in a nation-wide prayer.

October 6, 1871, was a memorable day. It was just six years after the founding of Fisk when 11 of her students, led by George White of the struggling school's faculty ,started out on a tour that was destined to be epoch-making in music and education. These young men and women of 1871 not only introduced to the world the song of the black folk, America's most signal contribution to the world's creative music, but they also began the building of a financial foundation which gave permanence to one of the institutions of higher learning for the then just freed black men.
