

NEGRO CIO LEADERS

IN TALK WITH PERKINS; ARMOUR STRIKE PLANNED

Washington, Sept. 7 (CNA)-Fifteen Armour local delegates from all over the country, in cluding four Negroes, told Federal government here that either Armour management would negotiate with the union for a national contract, or "we will shut down every Armour plant in the country, and keep them shut down until we get an agreement." The delegation was headed by Packinghouse Workers Organizing Committee Chairman Van A. Bittner.

Negro members of the delegation were Henry Johnson, assis- [tant national director of the PWOC: Clifton McKinney, a leading member of Local 8, Omana, Neb., Oscar Wilson, from Local 347 in Armour's main Chicago plant; and Burdette King, President of the PWOC's newly chartered Local 100 of the Armour's by-products plant at 31st Street, Chicago. This local recently received 660 of the 848 ballots east in a Labor board election, and has been certified by the board as the sole bargaining agent for employes at that

The delegation urged the government, through Secretary of abor Perkins to use all possible nfluence to bring Armour & Co. the conference table, both through her office and, if that failed, through President Roose-

"There is only one way to prevent a strike," Chairman Eittner told the Secretary "and that is by Armour and Co., consenting to negotiate. And if a nke is not prevented by this means, it will come before this

Labor day, September 4." A large number of Negro worktrs are employed in the Armour plants, particularly in Chicago. They are almost unanimously ior the CIO union.
