Since 95 per cent of the land owners in the Santee Cooper basin are Negroes the Governor's action in their behalf is being commended. He said last Saturday:

"I talked with Dr. Foreman by telephone in Washington today and asked him to confer with Mr. Pearce and Mr. Cooper (chairman and general manager of the Authority) on the land acquision question, in order that the people might get a fair and equitable price for their land and at the same time not make it too burdensome for the Government in the purchase of the land.


