

Add chocolate to milk and heat in double boiler. When chocolate is melted, beat with rotary egg beater until blended. Combine sugar, cornstarch, and salt: add small amount of chocolate mixture. stirring until smooth; return to double boiler and cook until thickened, stirring constantly. Then continue cooking 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add small amount of mixture to egg yolks, stirring vigorously; return to double boiler and cook 2 minutes longer, stirring constantly. Add vanilla and turn into greased baking dish. Beat egg whites until foamy throughout; add sugar, 2 each addition until sugar is blend-Then continue beating until mixture will stand in peaks. Pile lightly on chocolate mixture and by distilling the leaves of the bay-berry, a West Indian tree of the myrtle family.
