### Twenty-Two Surplus Foods On New List

Twenty-two surplus foods are on the official surplus list for the period from September 2 to September 30, inclusive, according to an announcement by Phillip B. Lush, Local Representative for the Surplus Marketing Administration in this area. All of the items are exchangeable for blue food stamps which are given free on the basis of 50 cents worth for each dollar's worth of orange stamps purchased.

The complete list follows: butter, raisins, rice, pork lard, pork corn meal, shell eggs, dried prunes, hominy, split, dry edible beans, wheat flour, white wheat (Graham) flour, fresh oranges, fresh apples, fresh pears, fresh peaches, fresh carrots, fresh beets, fresh cabbage, fresh celery, fresh corn and fresh tomatoes.

The new item on the list for this area is fresh carrots. Fresh snap beans have been deleted from the list.
