

MASS. DEMOCRATS NAME NEGRO PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR

Cambridge, Mass., Oct. 10 (ANP) Dr. Silas F. Taylor, prominent Democratic leader and former member of the state parole board and director of colored voters, was chosen presidential elector Saturday by Massachusetts State Democratic convention at Springfield.

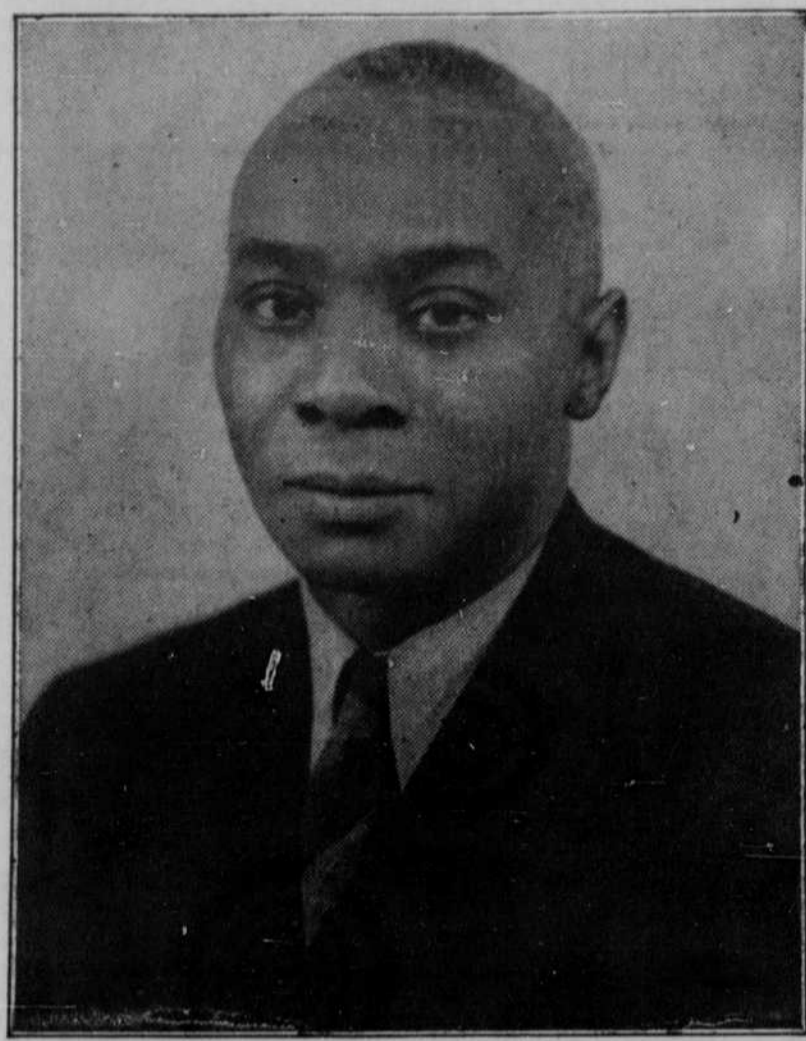
Dr. Taylor also is credited with introducing the anti-lynch plank in the state Democratic platform and fighting for more liberal social security laws covering domestic workers.

TUSKEGEE BALANCES ITS BUDGET

Tuskegee Institute, Ala., Oct. 10 (ANP) According to the auditor's report just issued by the firm of Charles F. Rittenhouse and Company of Boston, the Tuskegee Institute for the year ending June 1, 1940, has lived well within a balanced budget and "the results for the year are more nearly on a 'cash' basis than they have apparently been for several years".

Commenting further relative to the year's operation, the report attributes this commendable condition to "an improved control of expenditures" and "to the reduction and modification of facilities and departments".

President F. D. Patterson expressed satisfaction that despite difficulties attendant upon the re-trenchment program necessary to keep Tuskegee Institute within the budget, it has been possible to build up the Employees' Retirement Reserve for the security of members of the faculty and staff whose term of service at the Institute shall mature because of the age limit or ill health.

URGE SOUTHERN HEALTH OFFICERS TO TRAIN NEGRO PHYSICIANS

Washington, Oct. 10 (ANP) — Medical circles are watching with interest developments in public health in the southern states, hopeful that additional barriers may be broken down as a result of a resolution fostered by Dr. M. O. Bousfield of Chicago at a recent meeting held here. Dr. Bousfield was one of the invited guests at the meeting of State and Territorial Health Officers which convened at the U. S. Public Health Building. When the subject of national defense was broached, Director Baker of Alabama introduced a resolution suggested by Dr. Bousfield, urging southern state health offi-

cers to provide ways and means of training additional Negro doctors within their states in public health. The resolution carried. Dr. Thom as Parran, U. S. Surgeon General, presided at the meeting.

Baltimoreans Move Into New Housing Project

Baltimore, Oct. 10 (ANP) Tuesday was moving day as 298 families moved into the big \$1,107,500 Edgar Allen Poe Federal Housing Project on a site that 18 months ago was one of the city's worst slum districts. The project covers an area of six blocks.
