#### HOW TO DETECT COUNTERFEIT COINS

1. KNOW YOUR MONEY!

2. RING all coins on a hard surface. Genuine coins sound clear and bell-like. Counterfeits sound dull.

3. FEEL all coins. Most counterfeit coins feel greasy.

4. COMPARE the reeding (the corrugated outer edge) of a suspected coin with one known to be genuine. The ridges on genuine coins are distinct and evenly spaced. On counterfeit coins they are poorly spaced and irregular.

#### HOW TO CASH GOVERNMENT CHECKS

1. KNOW YOUR ENDORSERS!

2. DEMAND definite identification of the payee.

3. COMPARE endorsement on check with signature on iden-

4. WPA workers carry cards with identification number, signature and physical description, If you cash WPA checks, compare these three things and make sure the description fits that of the person presenting the check.

5. BE CAUTIOUS about cashing a check on which the payee's address is far removed from your place of business.



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



Washington, D. C., March 12 -Word from Spokane Wash that a proposed 6 1-2 million dollar municipal power venture had been over thrown by the electorate was considered in the capital tonight as further evidnce of a growing insur rection against federal power dictation in the northwest.

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


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
