**Methodists Devote \$5,000 to Sending Harlem Youngsters to Summer Camps**

Children learning arts and crafts, archery, Indian lore at summer camps.

Harlem Methodist ministers were called into Conference recently by Dr. Fred B. Newell, executive secretary of the Methodist New York City Society. "We have \$5,000 we wish to spend for the best interests of your people," he said. "How shall we use it?" "Summer camps for our children," the pastors decided.

Mr. Alvin L. Wilks was appointed Methodist Camp Service Director. Applications were received in all of Harlem's seven churches of the denomination. Full or partial scholarships were granted as needed, so that 350 faithful Sunday School youngsters are enjoying a two-weeks stay at one or another of several well-established and equipped camps. In most cases parents defrayed travel costs and the 25¢ fee for physical examinations.
