URGE ALL TO ASSIST IN T-B CAMPAIGN

Nebraskans are urged to assist the Nebraska Tuberculosis Association in its campaign to regain the state's previous record of the lowest death rate from tuberculosis in the nation, lost last year. The association points out that there are over 1,500 active cases of this infectious disease in the state right now. The first and greatest need in the campaign against tuberculosis is general understanding of the facts about this disease and the methods with which it must be fought.

A continuous year-round educational program is being carried on all over the state by the Nebraska Tuberculosis Association. One of the many activities against tuberculosis is the tuberculin skin test clinics being held in many communities in Nebraska.

Briefly, here are some of the facts that are a part of the educational program: Tuberculosis is infectious, not hereditary and it is curable in early cases. Avoid contact with active cases. Realize the importance of good health habits. Consult your doctor regularly for a physical examination. Knowledge and its application will win the fight against tuberculosis.
