

CHRISTMAS BUREAU WILL OPERATE AGAIN

The Christmas Bureau will operate again this year under the sponsorship of the Council of Social Agencies, a Community Chest Agency, to insure that the gifts of Omahans to the needy will not be duplicated by other givers while

some other deserving families are neglected. This was announced by Mr. Fred Laux, Chairman of the Bureau. Mrs. J. M. White will again be in charge of the work.

Headquarters have been established at 415 Barker Bldg., Mr. Laux said. Persons or organizations wishing to take care of a family for Christmas can get the name of a family by going to the Barker Building or by telephoning Jackson 7161. If you or your organization have already adopted a family for Christmas giving, call or write the Bureau, giving names and addresses of the family and telling what you are giving (food, clothing, toys, etc.) The Bureau will check to see that the family you have chosen has not been adopted and registered to someone else; if so, you will be informed and may then select another family not already cared for—one which otherwise might have a cheerless Christmas.

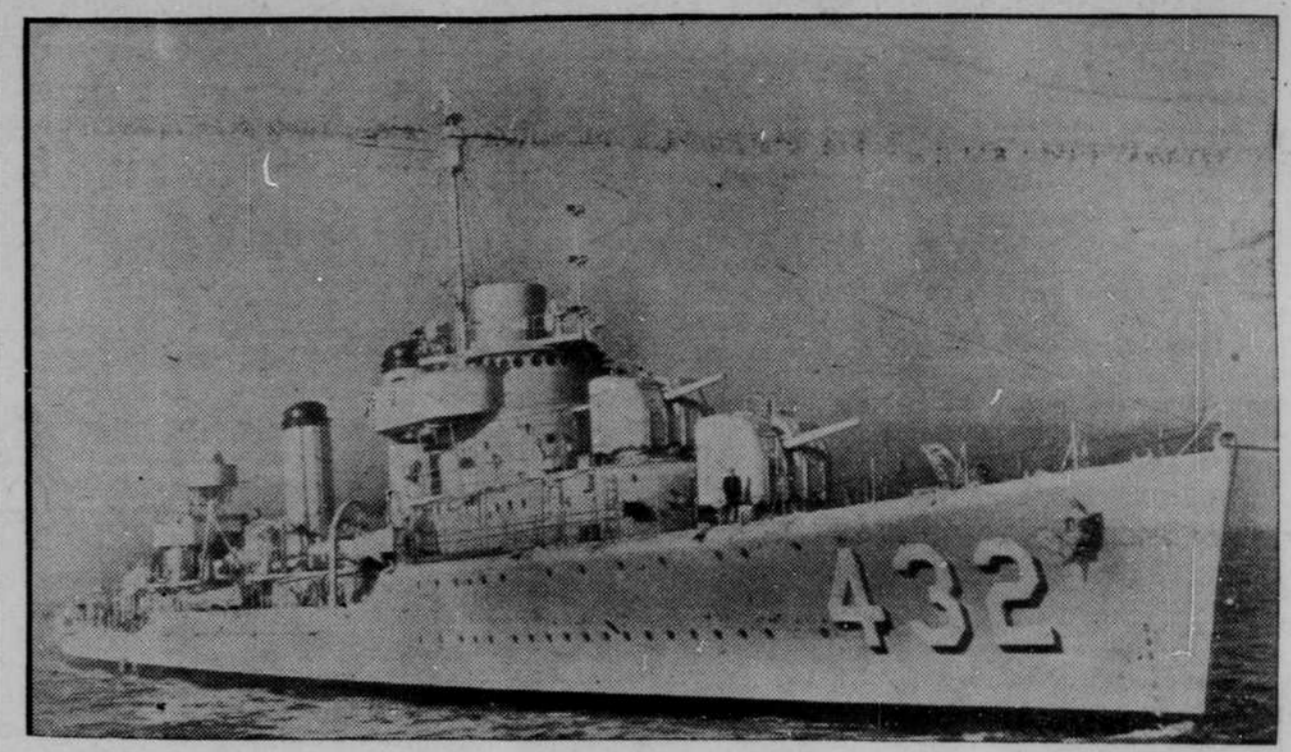

OPM NEGRO WORKERS NOW COVER NATION Washington, Dec. 2 (ANP)—Members of the labor supply and training division of OPM, according to Dr. Robert C. Weaver of that office, are assigned to various areas and are known as field workers.

of training and employment and reports turned into the office on progress being made in the matter of Negro employment. Asked about the situation in Delaware where the DuPonts are supposed to be opposed to the hiring of Negroes, Dr. Weaver said the lack of training of Negroes in this section was largely responsible for the failure to secure employment in such plants as the DuPonts operate in the state.
