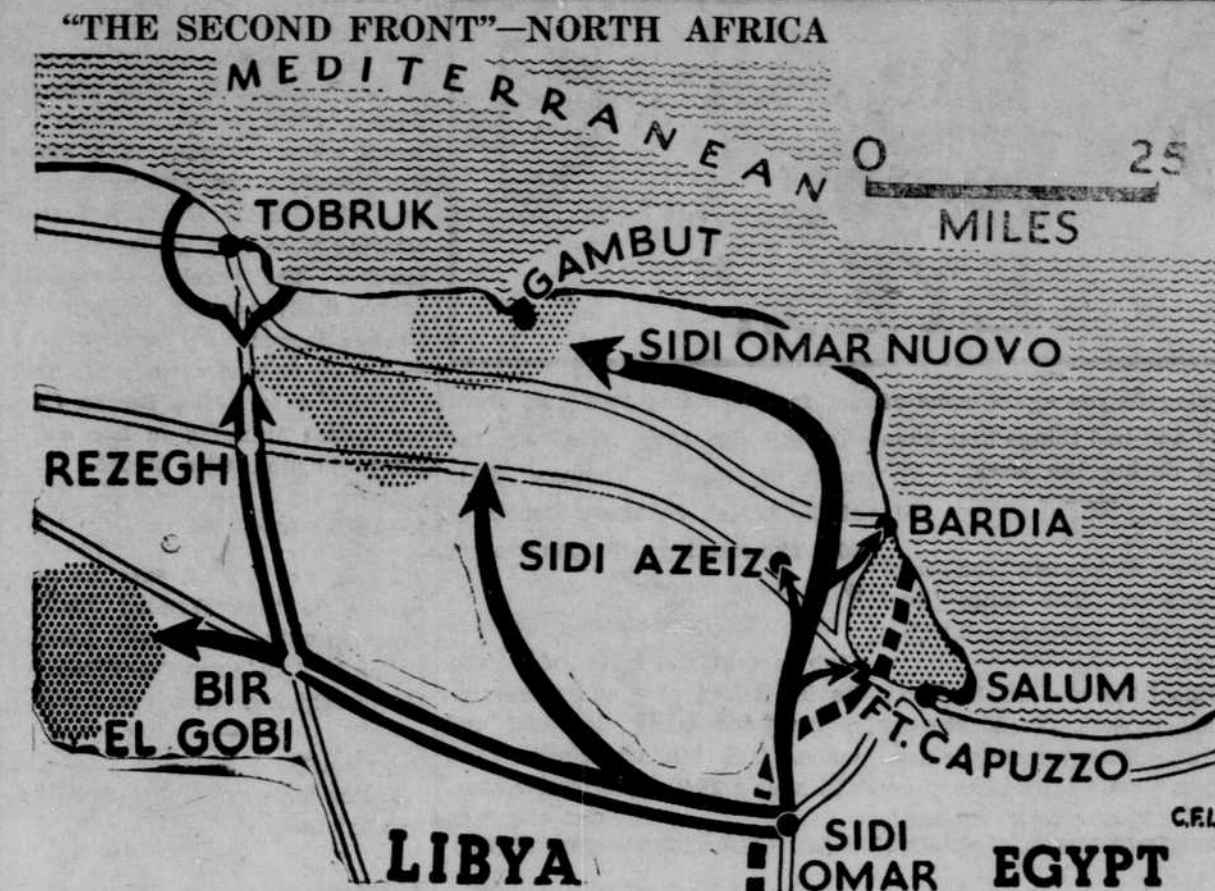
**Well Cats, you won't be seeing**
