# People of Omaha Have Right To Vote

The people of Omaha are entitled to vote on the question of whether or not they wish the Nebraska Power Company and its present electric service turned over to municipal ownership.

As the situation now stands, under the provisions of L. B. 204, the people do not have the right to vote on this question if Omaha's electric service were taken over by condemnation pro-
