Senator Filibuster doesn't like anybody who tries to make democracy work. Senator Filibuster was "elected" by a handful of voters. A "permanent" politician, he keeps coming back to Congress term after term . . . and he has a death-like grip on important Congressional committees.

In the last Congress, he killed the Geyer-Pepper anti-poll tax bill in the Senate after it passed the House. He has threatened to filibuster again this fall-for 15 months if necessary-to keep the Senate from voting on HR 7. the anti-poll tax bill which passed the House in May of this year by 265-110.

YOU PERSONALLY CAN LICK SENATOR FILI-BUSTER. His endless speech making can be stopped. It is called invoking cloture and it takes a 2/3 vote of the Senators. Millions of Negro American citizens must write their Senators to vote for cloture—and CONTINUE to vote for cloture until debate IS limited.

In September, the Senate comes back to Washington to go to work. If you, your friends, and every Negro organization write their Senators today to vote for cloture and passage of HR 7, the poll tax and Senator Filibuster will go down to defeat.
