The NAACP official felt that a strong stand by Dewey supporting cloture might have influenced the 23 uncommitted and opposing Republican senatores to do likewise! A Dewey spokesman asserted, however, that "any statement he might make on that question might be interpreted as a bid for the presidency which Gov.
