Communion was given at the close of the evening worship. Again a good time, rejoicing in the God of our salvation was had by all. Special effort for the month is the trip to Canaan.



Sis. Corrine Harris, who has been a house guest at the parsonage, left Monday morning for her home in Liberty, Mo.






