New York (CNS) One of the greatest of women blues singers, Jersey-born Miss Rhapsody, is looking for a new day in her profession.

She hopes that presently the public will give an artist her recognition when she chirps blue notes at the mike and let her walk off the stage into her own private life, without being "classed" for the songs she has just sang.

"Of course, part of the fault lies not only on the public, but on the artist herself," the brownskin blues specialist emphasized as she pointed a warning finger in the 42nd Street office of her manager, Bill Graham.
