RANDOLPH SAYS NEGROES SHOULD SUPPORT JOHN L. LEWIS FIGHT FOR WAGE INCREASE New York, N.Y., March 12—The fight of the miners for an increase pay under the leadership of John L. Lewis deserves the cooperation and support of not only Negro workers but the Negro people as a whole. The basic reason why their struggle should be backed by Negroes is that it is a fight not only for the miners but for all of the American workers of which Negroes are a part. If the program of John L. Lewis prevails it will strengthen the forces of organized labor throughout the nation and give labor the moral resources in terms of faith and courage to withstand the assaults of the anti-labor forces of reaction that will confront the workers in the postwar world, observed Randolph in the International Headquarters of the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters.




