The American Red Cross will emphasize its home nursing program during National Negro Health Week April 1-8. Sponsored by the U. S. Public Health Service, the three-day observance of this week devoted to Negro health will have for its special objective, "A Healthy Family in a Healthy Home."

Dr. Charlotte Hawkins Brown, founder and president of Palmer Memorial Institute, Sedalia, N. C., a member of the National Council on Red Cross Home Nursing, and Dr. Mary McLeod Bethune, president of the National Council of Negro Women, are outspoken in their praise of this program of instruction.
