Let's be intolerant of intolerance. Apply yourself to a better understanding of your neighbor. Teach your children to respect other human beings, whatever their race or religion or national origin. If they repeat the cliches of intolerance, set them right at once, before prejudice takes root in another young mind.

All of us who have our eyes open know that intolerance is rife now in these United States. The hard ships of wartime, the sacrifices and losses and discomforts, are always helpful to the salesman of diviive ideas. The more reason, therefore, for raising your sales resistance to propaganda of group hatred.

I don't call intolerance "unAmerican" because that is not a strong enough term. I call it inhuman. It cannot be fought with laws. It cannot be dealt with at conference tables. The place in which to combat intolerance is your own home, your own club, your own church, your wn mind.

It's a challenge to you and to me, to every father and mother, to every teacher, to every community

If we are to have lasting peace in the world, if we are to conserve those traditional freedoms we proud ly call American, tolerance must prevail.

Of what lse will it be for the lights to go on again all over the world if they do not go on in our hearts?
