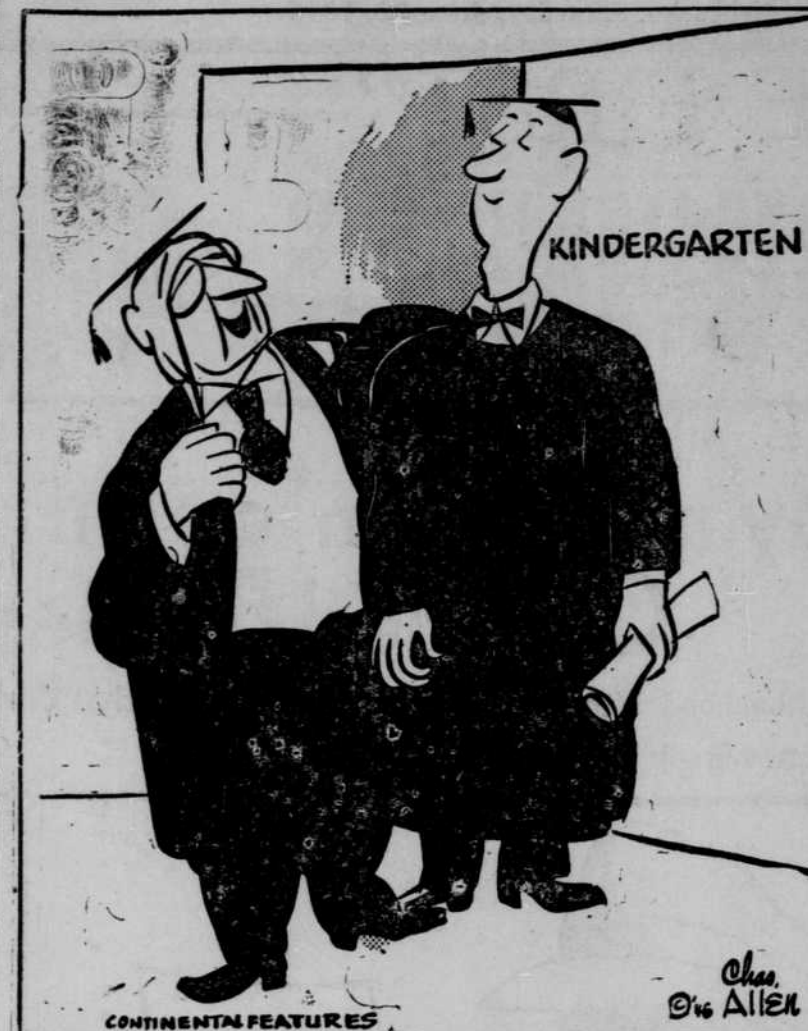

In a speech made over WOW radio station on the Noonday Forum program Tuesday, June 11, Mrs. Grey told of the part our people are playing and should play in this drive.

1. She urged every family to be conservative in their meals to the extent that it does not affect their health.

2. They are putting posters in grocery stores and distributing pamphlets explaining how to lower America's waste record.

3. Many families are raising gardens.

4. Showing films.

5. Ministers are stressing the need in their churches and preaching sermons on the subject.

Monday afternoon, June 17 at 3:30 a picture "Suffer Little Children" was shown at the Urban League. Col. Pearley was the speaker.

Later Saturday afternoon Mrs. Brooks and Mrs. Grey took their display to White's Market.
